ReFresh Milwaukee Energy Goals



- Improve residential and commercial energy efficiency in Milwaukee.
- Replace fossil fuel energy use with more clean renewable energy in City of Milwaukee facilities.
- Grow Milwaukee's cluster of energy efficient and clean tech companies to create local jobs and exports.
- Increase community resilience and customer choice by removing the regulatory and institutional barriers to distributed renewable energy projects.



Energy Efficiency=Economic Development





- Cities need economic development tools to support existing buildings, not just new development.
- Reallocate budgets currently wasted on excess energy into building improvements that improve living conditions.
- We have an economic and moral obligation to take climate change seriously and take proactive steps to mitigate it.
- Wisconsin exports energy efficiency → economic driver for the State











Cash-Back Rewards

Commercial Buildings

- PACE financing overcomes financial barriers for energy efficiency, renewable energy, and water efficiency projects
- US Department of Energy has named our PACE program a national "implementation model"
- 8 projects valued at over \$13 million have been approved
- Part of larger Better Buildings Challenge Program

Utility Scale Solutions?

- State and PSC grants broad power to Investor Owned Utilities (IOU) in Wisconsin
- Limited investment in renewable energy by IOU utilities in WI



- Can we add a dose of democracy to our utility decisions?
- Milwaukee's intervention on Rate Cases, PSC dockets
- Utility-scale solar, community solar, and power purchase agreements are all elusive in IOU service territories.
