<b>Vat (plastic tub) options:</b> Home Depot Amazon Used storage tub	1	\$0-\$25	At least 4" deep
<b>Fiber options:</b> <a href="#">Carriage House</a> <a href="#">Shared Studio</a>  Recycled scraps	1 lb	\$0-\$80	Pre-beaten 1hr fiber is for high quality paper. Recycled scraps makes low quality paper. Recycled watercolor paper makes high quality paper. 2 lbs (dry weight) of fiber makes about 100 (8x10) sheets
<b>Kitchen Blender options:</b> Used  Storebought	1	\$0-\$25	A kitchen blender is used to beat recycled scraps (it doesn't provide the same quality of fiber beaten by a beater). Blenders that can crush ice work best.
<b>Pulp painting options:</b> Recycled colored scraps Squeeze bottles Disperse pigments with retention agent		\$0-\$100	
<b>Press options:</b> Wood boards Sponge with rolling pin <a href="#">Arnold Grummer (press and dryer)</a>	1	\$0-\$350	
<b>Dryer options:</b> Wood boards, heavy books, bricks Window, formica, clothes pins <a href="#">Drying box</a>	1	\$0-\$100	
<b>Other helpful tools:</b> measuring cups and spoons, yogurt containers, turkey baster, strainer, waterproof boots and apron		\$0-\$20
